In addition to legal requirements in this area, we will unconditionally ensure that our employees are not injured at their workplace.

Based on our knowledge, we have learned that many of the instruments which will be sent for calibration, service and / or test, has been used or mounted in a medium which may be harmful by touch. We have therefore introduced a procedure to ensure that no one of our employees touches equipment, without a decontamination statement from the customer / user ensuring that no media is present on the equipment that is toxic, corrosive or poses any other health hazard.

That's why you as a customer are approached about filling out a so-called Decontamination statement - it is solely to ensure our employees, and to avoid possible, cross contamination with other equipment.

If your production never appears harmful substances, it is possible to make a general statement that applies to all instruments we receive from you – but as a starting point there must be a statement per instrument or per shipment of instruments, if all the instruments have been decontaminated in the same way. In addition to information relating to use of the instrument, it must also be given on how the instrument has been decontaminated.

The Decontamination Statement can be downloaded from our website, filled out and printed, as well as attached to instruments.

This is also a procedure that most of our suppliers require if the equipment is to be returned to the factory.

If the instrument requires a special kind of decontamination please specify.
